Thank you for considering Hanalani Schools. As you have many excellent choices for education on Oahu, I appreciate your interest in us. Since the process of applying to independent schools can sometimes be a daunting and overwhelming experience, the following information is provided to assist you.

- Our application process is a rolling process. Once a grade is filled, additional qualified applicants are placed into a wait pool. We encourage you to submit your application as early as possible.
- Applicants to grade 12 must submit copies of their scores on the Scholastic Aptitude Test.
- Applicants to grades 9-11 are required to take the Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT). Please refer to the enclosed pamphlet for registration information and deadlines. You may also register online at [www.ssaf.org](http://www.ssaf.org).
- Appointments for assessment of applicants for grades 7 and 8 will be scheduled when we receive your completed application.
- Students applying to grades 7 and 8 will receive a phone call or confirmation letter regarding test dates and times. If you do not hear from us, please contact our office.
- Please follow the enclosed checklist that provides instructions and a list of required documents.

We hope to see you at one of our Admissions Preview Days or other Hanalani events, such as drama productions or athletic events. If you are interested in shadowing a current student for the day, please contact my office to make arrangements. Our goal is to help each prospective applicant in determining if Hanalani is the "right fit" for you and your family.
