Students participate in theme-oriented activities and field trips. Light academic work is also included.</p>

<p><b>Annual Payment Plan</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>— 100% of school bill due on <b>Wednesday, July 5, 2017</b></li> <li>— Receives \$400 discount off of the base tuition. This discount does not apply to families receiving TAP (Tuition Assistance Program) funds or additional scholarships. This discount does not apply to families enrolling in the middle of the school year.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Family Discount</b> ..... 10%</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>— Families who have more than one student enrolled receive a 10% discount off of the base tuition (not including fees) for the second student and each student thereafter. Family discount is based on natural relationship or adoption. This discount does not apply to families receiving TAP (Tuition Assistance Program) or additional scholarships.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Semi-Annual Payment Plan</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>— 50% of school bill due on <b>Wednesday, July 5, 2017</b></li> <li>— Remaining 50% of school bill due on <b>Tuesday, December 5, 2017</b></li> </ul>	<p><b>Appreciation Referral Credit</b> ..... \$750</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>— Hanalani Schools extends a \$750 (domestic) or \$1,000 (international) appreciation referral credit (per student) to a currently-enrolled family that refers a student who enrolls in Hanalani for a full year.           <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The referred family must indicate the name of the referring family on their enrollment contract.</li> <li>2) When the new student enrolls, the appreciation referral credit will be applied to the referring family's account over two semesters — \$375/\$500 to the first semester and \$375/\$500 to the second semester, or prorated accordingly.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
<p><b>Monthly Payment Plan</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>— Monthly payments due on the 5th or 20th of each month from July 2017 to April 2018.</li> <li>— A \$175 plan fee is charged per family</li> <li>— Accounts on the monthly payment plan must be on auto-debit.</li> </ul>	



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
