PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Royal Merit Scholarship (RMS) program is intended to recognize incoming students in Grades 7-12 who demonstrate commitment and diligence in the pursuit of high-level accomplishment and excellence. Excellence is a process and by-product of hard work, dedication, and talent. Royal Merit Scholarships are awarded to students involved in co-curricular activities, as we believe that these activities provide valuable learning venues for developing 21st century and leadership skills. Students may reapply each year for the RMS program.

OVERALL PROCESS

1. Student Portfolio:

- Co-Curricular Activity:* Student must participate in a school-sponsored co-curricular activity.
- Essay:* Student must submit a typed essay (maximum 250 words) that addresses the following question: What role does (you may pick a specific co-curricular activity) play in my life?
- Mentor References:* Student must submit two **Mentor Reference Report (US-08)** forms from a coach, instructor, or a pastor who can speak to his/her character and attitude.

2. Interview/Audition: STEM and Leadership applicants will be contacted by a respective committee member to schedule an interview session. Fine Arts applicants will be contacted by a respective committee member to schedule an audition session. Auditions must be performed on the proficiency selected on the RMS Proficiency Selection form (located on the back).

ROYAL MENTOR SCHOLARSHIP

The **Royal Mentor Scholarship** is awarded to an upper-level student who goes beyond the criteria for the Royal Merit Scholarship by committing to dedicate time and talent to mentor and develop younger students, i.e., a minimum of one hour per week to provide instrument instruction, robotic mentoring, etc.
